Footnotes

THE TAPINATOR away well, appeared to be forced in slightly approaching the end of the homestretch, reacting as FR. PETER'S MISSAL was maneuvering for position himself before reaching the first turn, settled near the inside soon afterwards and stayed there until placed three wide down the backstretch at the midway point, took the three path during the run around the second bend, ranged up and made a bid just before completing six furlongs, forged to the front and extended the margin making his way to the eighth pole, kicked away from the competition from that station, kept to a drive. TWO RICHARDS out sprinted LUCKY LIL LIAM for the lead, had that rival in attendance parked just off the hind quarters for nearly three-quarters, was closer to the two path than the rail down the backstretch, but was guided over to the inside leaving the half mile pole, halting the middle move being undertaken by SUSPICIOUS U at that juncture, met a fresh challenger in the form of the eventual winner approaching the five-sixteenths pole, offered some resistance before relinquishing, held well for the place. SUSPICIOUS U took the inside route, was steadied off heels when put in tight shortly before reaching the first turn, regained the lost ground and momentum and soon rejoined the pack, was let out a notch and launched a middle move nearing the end of the backstretch along an inviting clear passageway along the rail, had the move stymied when the pacesetter was sent over to close the hole by taking up residence once again along the inside at the seven-sixteenths pole, lost some ground and momentum for a second time, cut the corner under strong encouragement and came home with good courage to grab the show. FR. PETER'S MISSAL bobbed at the break, raced from off the inside, was taken in hand as the runner up took up position along the rail nearing the second turn, swung wide into the stretch, flattened out in the last eighth. LUCKY LIL LIAM urged from the starting gate, got out sprinted by TWO RICHARDS for the front, prompted that opponent from the outside for almost six furlongs before backing away. HAVING A NICE TIME three wide until the five-sixteenths pole, folded. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on THE TAPINATOR after leaving the starting gate before the result was declared official.
