Footnotes

PHYSICAL DELIVERY three wide in close range initially, absconded the front in tandem with SOUL OPPOSITION at the seven-sixteenths, dueled through the turn with that foe while along the rail, cut the corner into the stretch, fought on to take a narrow advantage at the eighth pole, dug in gamely to put away her main foe in the last jumps and prevail. SOUL OPPOSITION four wide in close pursuit early on, dueled for command from the seven-sixteenths just off the inside of her main foe, was roused at the five-sixteenths, fought on stubborn losing a slim lead a furlong out, dug in with good effort but was ultimately out gamed in the last jumps. CITY GONE WILD broke awkwardly, settled three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the three-eighths pole, progressed into prominence nearing the top of the stretch, spun three wide at that juncture, offered up a mild kick to secure the show honors on the line. CURRENT EVENT settled towards the rear four wide, came under urging in tandem with CITY GONE WILD three furlongs out, progressed with that rival into contention at the quarter pole, offered up a mild kick through the stretch matching strides with the aforementioned rival but lost the bob on the line for the show while clear for the last major share. CHLOE BEAR broke out at the start squeezing BRICKHOUSE BABY in tandem with LA BELLA CHABELLA, was on the pace early along the inside, came off the rail down the backside, lost the lead nearing the half mile pole as LIFE'S A STAGE ranged up inside, lost further position at the seven-sixteenths, came under a ride at the three-eighths pole and steadily weakened in the stretch. LA BELLA CHABELLA broke in at the start squeezing BRICKHOUSE BABY after the start in tandem with CHLOE BEAR, raced rank under restraint off heels around the first turn until able to settle near the five and a half, came under urging from mid pack three furlongs from home, made little headway then weakened in the lane. LIFE'S A STAGE tracked inside early on, ranged up to seize brief command at the half mile pole, yielded the front a sixteenth later, retreated through the turn and tired. BRICKHOUSE BABY got squeezed after the start by pressure from both sides, settled two to three wide at the rear, raced well off the inside through the far turn and trailed.
