EXPRESSION bobbed at the start, was unhurried down the backstretch, departed the half mile pole four wide and raced as the widest of all around the turn, picked up interest and cruised up towards the front runners a furlong down the road, entered the stretch, responded positively when given her cue, arrived at the eighth pole as the new leader, drew out to a comfortable advantage, then was geared down for the final seventy yards. ALIRAVEN grabbed the early advantage using her own power, cut the pace, with the rider attempting to keep something in reserve, turned for home with a firing line spread out across the track right behind and got asked for run, surrendered the front to the top one soon afterwards, held on well enough late to salvage second. WE NEED V L T'S raced along the outside, closed the gap under some light encouragement late on the turn, was grabbed hold, pausing behind a wall of rivals coming to the quarter pole, was put back to urging two strides later, got tipped into the five path, getting placed now as the widest of all at this juncture, came home with good energy, but missed out on the place. ELUSIVE JOZI lightly coaxed while giving chase three wide on the turn, flattened out. EASY ENDING pressed the issue from the outside for a half before giving way. GRANBY GIRL saved ground for nearly a half, got fanned outward until four wide turning for home, had no rally. MAGNIFICENT MIA tracked the leader from the pocket, began to lose his best action past the three-sixteenths pole, fell back and was quickly eased, got pulled up and was subsequently vanned off.
