MOR CHANCES set a lively pace while racing along the inside, needed only one smack of the whip leaving the furlong grounds then completed the race from that point on under a vigorous hand ride. EXECUTIVE SEARCH waited patiently off the leader while taking the inside route, angled outward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole while commencing his rally, had to settle for being second best. BE BULLISH took the overland route and finished a non-threatening third. CITIFEST chased three wide and gave way. GOLD AND ROSES underwent a four wide journey and tired. GOOD CARD mildly pursued the leader for a half before folding.
