HAYA'S BOY urged to the front, set a loose lead under a hold while in the two path, moved closer to the rail entering the turn, lengthened away through the turn under his own power, was let out at the quarter pole and held his advantage through the stretch while kept busy, drifted in and out late in response to the rider's stick work. TOKEN SACRIFICE chased the front while three wide throughout, came under urging to close the gap near the three-eighths, kicked on readily to secure the place safely while no match for the aforementioned rival. CAP THE MOMENT stumbled at the start and was off slow as a result, settled at the rear, swung four wide at the quarter pole, was asked at that station for run, closed with good late energy belatedly for the show. GINGER'S JOE chased the pace three wide, came under encouragement at the head of the lane, offered up a mild bid being out kicked in the late stages and settled for the last major share. MOLLY'S SHIP allowed to settle early on, came under a ride at the quarter pole, angled out near the three-sixteenths for a clear lane and passed tired foes in the lane. MODERN CHILD hustled from the gate, settled into a good pocket trip, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths and steadily faded thereafter. CREA'S LAW saved ground throughout, came under a prolonged drive from the three-eighths and offered no response.
