SOSPECHOSO (CHI), close up along the rail early, angled out and came wide into the stretch, dug in gamely and was up in the final yards. DOUBLE SCREEN contested the pace while three wide, earned a short lead inside the eighth pole and dug in gamely but could not resist the winner. GOLDEN ECHO reared at the start and was outrun early then finished gamely along the inside. DARING DAVID contested the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. LETTHEDREAMBEGIN chased between rivals and lacked a solid finishing punch. THUNDER BOW chased three wide and had no rally. DICE FLOE contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch.
