EARLY RESPONSE set the pace under pressure for a half, opened a clear advantage on the turn and drew away under steady urging. JUSTIN P saved ground to the turn, stayed inside in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. DAVY'S BANK pressed the winner from outside to the turn and weakened. MARSCAPONI raced between horses for five furlongs, lagged back on the turn and lacked a late response. PRINCEOFPROXIMITY saved ground to no avail. TOP LEADER lodged a four wide move on the turn and flattened out. MEL'S GOLD raced up close to the turn and tired. CHIEF TASHMO was outrun.
