ENDLESS CIRCLE set the pace along the rail, shook loose in midstretch and held off the runner-up under a vigorous hand ride. IDAHO JOE dropped back in hand early, circled five wide at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. OVEREXTENDED trailed for a half while saving ground and finished strongly along the rail to gain a share. BANKING HOLIDAY was outrun after breaking a bit slowly, angled four wide at rallied mildly. ADMIRALTY steadied in tight at the half mile pole, checked in traffic on the turn, made a run to threaten in midstretch and weakened. HEDGE FUND pressed the winner into upper stretch and tired. PHILHARMONIC rushed up on the rail, raced up close early, steadied sharply and was shuffled back on the turn and was never close thereafter. HUBBARD chased three wide, raced up close for a half and gave way.
