Footnotes

ALMIGHTY SILVER settled in good position while saving ground, raced in midpack along the rail leaving the turn, waited for room while boxed in at the quarter pole, altered course to the outside to get clear at the furlong marker and finished with a flourish to get up in the final strides. NAUGHTY NEW YORKER settled in good position, stalked three wide for a half, surged to the front from outside on the turn, maintained a slim lead into midstretch, battled into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. DR. D. F. C. was unhurried for five furlongs, lodged a three wide move on the turn, made a run to threaten in midstretch and finished willingly to gain a share. SUMMER SHARE lunged in the air at the start, rushed up inside, dueled to the turn, fought heads apart into midstretch and weakened late. EXECUTIVE SEARCH raced just off the pace between horses for six furlongs, angled out entering the stretch and finished evenly. GOOD LAW broke in the air at the start breaking well behind the field and failed to threaten thereafter. FREDDY THE CAP dueled heads apart in the two path to the turn and gave way then pulled up in distress after the finish and was vanned off.
