Footnotes

LUTE sat within range off an ongoing pace dispute, moved when ready, angled three wide approaching the five-sixteenths pole, flashed a touch of speed, accelerating towards the survivor of the duel, went by, emerged from the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage and fended off the drifting runner up to hold safely to the wire. SHE'S FIRED UP was unhurried for nearly three-quarters, loosely drafted the winner into the stretch, gained readily on that one, despite drifting outward during the last eighth. DEAN AVENUE dueled from the outside with DANCE CARD FILLED, was briefly clear on the lead about midpoint on the far turn, came under assault from the top one, had little left to turn back that one's bid, succumbed and tired steadily thereafter. BEAUTIFUL PICO saved ground, angled outward in the stretch and bested the rest. DANCE CARD FILLED eager during the open stages, resisted an attempt to ease back a bit leaving the opening bend, raced along the inside dueling with DEAN AVENUE and was through after completing three-quarters. MISS CRABTREE off a beat slowly, saved ground and failed to menace. JACK N JULE was through after going a half. GALAXY JET three wide around both turns, stopped.
