STRATEGIC MOVE assumed a forward position after the start, sat perched three wide off an ongoing pace dispute, being coaxed to keep pace during the run around the bend, went after the surviving member of the skirmish nearing the quarter pole, wrested away the lead in upper stretch then held sway under strong handling to the end. WHATEVERITTAKES broke slowly, and appeared sluggish during the early going, settled into stride, raced in the two path between foes for most of the way around the turn, gained readily when asked for a response in upper stretch, altered course outward a couple of paths at the eighth pole to continue the pursuit and finished well belatedly. THE ZIPSTER chased the duelists almost from the get-go, swung four wide into the lane and rallied mildly to be a non-threatening third. HOT MINUTE bumped lightly with LOOKIN AT HER at the start, got hooked up in a spirited tussle with HEAD HEART HOOF while racing slightly off the inside, put away that opponent, came once more under the gun, this time feeling heat from the top one soon afterwards, resisted briefly before succumbing in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and steadily tired thereafter. SYSTEM RESTORE was off a beat slowly, was strung out three wide at the three-eighths pole, turned for home but lacked the necessary stretch response. CITIFEST placed in the four path midway on the turn, had no rally. LOOKIN AT HER bumped lightly with HOT MINUTE out of the gate, took up residence along the rail from the nine-sixteenths pole and was through after completing a half. HEAD HEART HOOF urged from the get-go contesting the pace from the outside, hastily retreated upon reaching the quarter pole.
