**Footnotes**

DIAMOND DISTRICT contently stalked the front runners from off the inside in midpack, was placed in three path for the run around the far turn and picked up the pace, went after SEA GAZE just after one had taken over the advantage, overhauled the aforementioned opponent and was let out, drew out to his biggest advantage with an eighth to go, saw the margin steadily dwindle down but reached the finish line in plenty of time to prevail. CRESCENT'S MON took the inside route, slipped to the outside leaving the midway point on the far turn, raced as a team with STUD MUFFIN heading for the quarter pole, took the two path into the stretch, displayed a good kick en route for the place. STUD MUFFIN well reserved along the outside for the opening half, travelled three wide on the second turn, was put to a prolonged drive, attempted to close the gap on the front runners while racing glued to the outside of the second place finisher, couldn't keep pace after entering the lane, but mustered up a mild, belated stretch response to secure the show. MARQUET REBEL three wide heading to the end of the homestretch sped past SEA GAZE, quickly tucked into the two path and just as quickly went up to join SCIBELLI on the front, gained a narrow lead down the backstretch, had it snatched away by SEA GAZE leaving the half mile pole, tried to stay within range thereafter under encouragement, but weakened. SEA GAZE was asked leaving the starting gate, arrived at the beginning of first turn, in between another pair, and was allowed to ease back, patiently stalked the front runners making his way to the end of the backstretch, launched a successful three wide challenge for command, came under pressure from the winner soon afterwards and was asked for some run, yielded after putting up brief resistance and tired. SECRET GETAWAY three wide on the far turn, was outrun. SCIBELLI vied for control along the inside for a half, faltered.
