**Footnotes**

FREUD'S NOTEBOOK grabbed a forward position after the start, was rated in the two path while accompanying the pacesetter throughout the initial half, got let out a notch leaving the half mile pole and increased the pressure, had little difficulty overtaking a much more energetically-handled MARLENE'S PEARL to lead the field into the stretch, got asked for run after settling into upper stretch, kicked well clear during the ensuing furlong and stayed well clear, hand urged home to complete the race. MISS TEQUILA raced three wide around both turns, and finished with good courage to take the place. SASTA GO LUCKY took the inside route, under a firm hold until the seven-sixteenths pole, was released from that grip and gradually worked her way to the outside, turned for home three wide, flattened out during the stretch drive. DECORATED COURT was strung out three wide until the end of the backstretch, was sent over to the inside in two stages during the run around the second turn, settling along the rail by the five-sixteenths pole, entered the stretch and lacked the needed response. CHALK PLAYER swung three wide into the backstretch, remained well off the inside thereafter and folded. MARLENE'S PEARL established early control after being put to some urging leaving the gate, showed the way from the inside, with the eventual winner parked two wide just to her outside, was put to the test upon entering the far turn, yielded despite being set down and retreated. THUNDER PRINCESS saved ground and wilted.
