PERFECT DRIVE away well, disputed the pace from the outside, shook off the fellow pace combatant prior to the quarter pole, spun into the stretch being asked for run, lengthened away during the ensuing furlong, maintained a healthy margin to the end under a brisk hand ride. BRAZEN KAT sparred with the winner from the inside, fell back steadily from the quarter pole to midstretch, then salvaged the place. CALLMETONY sat well placed from the outside off the embattled pair up front, at first under a firm hold and then being coaxed along to keep pace, came up empty for the stretch drive. HISTORY STARTS NOW was guided over to the inside leaving the backstretch, rode the rail around the bend, was angled towards the middle of the track during the stretch run, had no kick. FIFTY SENSE took the inside route for the opening half, was swung outward into the lane, tired. EVEN FRISKY was under encouragement nearly from the get-go, chased the battling front runners from the three path around the turn and folded.
