TRUE ROSE was in hand early on, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and drew clear late, driving. FAVORITE ENDING raced close up while three wide and continued on to earn the place prize. FAIR KATE contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. SASKYA raced close up inside while in hand, was steadied inside on the turn and offered a mild rally. PERSONAL DELIGHT contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. ALLEYCAT COAT was in hand while between rivals early, raced in traffic in the stretch and posed no threat. DECADENT DESIGNER had no rally.
