GENO GREEN quickly recovered after being bumped at the start to take charge, showed the way along the rail without facing any stiff resistance during the run around the bend, left the furlong grounds with a comfortable margin and maintained it under strong handling. Q THE MUSIC chased the winner from outside throughout and held well to secure the place. LOFTY BANNER was sluggish during the initial stages after being bumped at the start, was fanned three wide into the lane and had a good finish outside. TRIPLE GLORY saved ground and lacked the necessary stretch response. ABU RACER was bumped after leaping at the start, trailed while saving ground until being angled outward at the quarter pole, came home with good late energy. JUST DIXIE underwent a four wide journey. GIMME MY DOUGH bumped at the start, was no threat. KING OF KARAKORUM had a three wide trip and tired. STORM SHUTTLE was through after going a half.
