DOC CAN DO broke alertly from the starting gate to be quickly in front, set the pace while racing the inside, left the furlong grounds with a clear advantage and held safely under good handling. NIGHT IN TUNISA tracked the leader from the rail, failed to dent the top one's margin, but came home willingly to secure the place. NIGHTINTHESLAMMER lacked the needed bid. MILLER'S MINT mildly pursued the leader from the outside for a half before tiring. B D'S PHOENIX off a beat slow, raced well off the inside during the run around the bend, was fanned five wide into the lane, had no solid rally. BUDDHA POWER was no threat. ALL THE WAY HOME outrun for a half, was swung very wide at the top of the lane. BOB'S BIG HOPE gave way after going a half. DOCTOR PROBLUM offered little. HONOUR ABOVE SELF was through after going a half. BOBBY TWO PIECES saved ground throughout. .
