Footnotes

A ZERO TRAP patiently stalked the leader from the two path, ranged up to that rival after entering the second turn, took charge after being given his cue in upper stretch, held a clear advantage with a furlong remaining and had no trouble turning back any potential closers under confident handling thereafter. JOE CORRIGAN three wide around the opening bend, raced within striking distance, outfinished THE ZIPSTER for the place. THE ZIPSTER carved the pace along the inside while under the watchful eye of the top one, was powerless to stave off that on's bid despite encouragement during the run around the far turn, then was outfinished for the place in the late stages. TYPHOON TYCOON saved ground and lacked a rally. STOPBLUFFING rallied mildly by weak rivals during the stretch run. DEFREREOFTHEHEART raced three wide around the second and failed to reach a contending position. STORMY SUCCESS saved ground to no avail. RODEO HAND four wide around the far turn, was no menace. SUCCESS FEE raced three wide around both turns and tired.
