MOUNT KARAKORUM broke well and quickly established command, cut the pace from the inside, being mildly prompted by the runner up, was asked for a response entering the stretch, then safely held NEVERSAYWHEN at bay the rest of the way to prove best. NEVERSAYWHEN pressed the winner almost from the get-go, with the rider attempting to keep something in reserve, continued on the same scenario for nearly a half, was put to encouragement making his long-awaited challenge for command approaching the quarter pole, made no headway at all and had to settle for the place. FIDDLERS VETERAN bumped hard with TACONIC KNIGHT leaving the starting gate, settled along the outside, within striking distance of the front runner, bided time during the run around the bend, was roused by upper stretch and rallied well enough to be along for the show. MCGEE'S MIRICLE was quickly guided over to the inside, rode the rail, swung three wide into upper stretch and came home with a mild kick to grab the last major share. TACONIC KNIGHT bumped soundly at the start, was rushed up, under light encouragement, to assume the pocket, contently tracked the top one from there, angled three wide heading for the stretch but failed to fire once called upon. ANDROMEDAS DESTINY was never involved. MARKET ANALYSIS raced along the outside and displayed only brief foot.
