### Footnotes

BE BULLISH off alertly, was placed in hand and eased back soon after the start, alternated between the two path and the rail before choosing to take the inside route for the run around the bend, found room to maneuver back into the two path nearing the quarter pole, was put to encouragement after being straightened away, willingly split rivals at the three-sixteenths pole while unleashing his rally, collared SMOKIN HERO at the furlong marker and edged clear, being flashed the whip right handed to maintain a true course during the final seventy yards. SMOKIN HERO out sprinted this compact field of five under light urging to establish early command, cut the pace towards the inside, under the watchful eye of REREADTHEFOOTNOTES, was put to test by the one at the five-sixteenths pole, matched strides, with the rider of neither rival asking his mount for run until three-sixteenths pole, shook free briefly only to encounter the top one's challenge soon afterwards, relinquished at the eighth pole but continued on with good courage to be clearly second best. HEAVENLY BLAZE was bumped lightly just after the break, brought up the back of the pack for a half, swung four wide into upper stretch but proved no match for the top twosome. DRIVEN BY SOLAR underwent a three wide pursuit and backed off. REREADTHEFOOTNOTES drifted out a bit at the start, brushing with HEAVENLY BLAZE as a result, sat reserved, in hand, off the inside down the backstretch, advanced to take up quarters just behind the pacesetter departing the backstretch, moved when ready to challenge for the lead in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, raced as a team with that opponent until upper stretch, was finally called upon, but came up flat.
