FREUD'S NOTEBOOK left alertly and quickly established control, tucked along the rail well before reaching the end of the homestretch, rated kindly on a loosely-contested lead, was kept on hold until entering the stretch, responded positively when given her cue, scampering away to her biggest advantage by the eighth pole, fended off the runner up, crossing the wire under solid hand urging. SCHILLERETTE reserved along the outside, was tipped three wide and asked to pick up the pace departing the backstretch, took the three path during the run around the second bend, was already under strong handling turning for home, finished willingly for second, although never posing a serious threat to the top one. ERIN ENCHANTED underwent a ground-saving journey, was grabbed hold of cutting the corner into the lane, got turned loose, had no rally. GUYANA PRINCESS left the rail at the half mile pole, was no factor. SILVER PRIZE attended the pacesetter from the outside for six furlongs before giving way.
