TAKE DOWN TWO prompted the pace early on from just off the inside, vied between foes in the turn taking a slight advantage at the five-sixteenths, inched away to the quarter pole, was roused nearing the three-sixteenths, dug in to just hold on at the wire in a good effort. VEXOR attended a pair early on from the three path, ranged up engage them through the turn from the outside, got set down swinging three wide in upper stretch, rallied inside the final furlong willingly and just missed. QUICK MONEY just off the pace three wide in behind a trio, angled four wide under a drive at the head of the stretch, offered up a mild kick to secure the show honors. HE'S SO CHIC lunged at the start striking the off side stall getting off slow conceding three or four lengths to the front, chased three wide, came under urging three furlongs out, spun five wide into the stretch, offered up a mild bid while unable to impact the top three. ALCOMATCH on the pace inside under light prompting early, vied with a pair through the turn coming under a drive at the five-sixteenths when displaced, cut the corner into the lane and gave way.
