GROOMEDFORVICTORY rated in range of the leader from just off the inside, got set down at the quarter pole, took command in upper stretch, dug in under challenge from that same rival and held sway repulsing that foe to the wire. TWO IS TO MANY hustled from the start, crossed to the inside into the clubhouse turn to cut the pace in hand, remained patiently handled until challenged nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch, got headed in upper stretch, dug in fighting on to the line but was ultimately repulsed. GRAND RAPPORT tracked inside from afar, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home, offered up a mild kick through the lane for the show while unable to reel in the top pair. SON OF A GENERAL saved ground towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths and advanced through the latter portion of the turn improving position then made no further headway while along for the last major share. SOCIALSAUL three wide through the first turn, chased just off the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, angled three to four wide for home and weakened in the drive. SCOTUS three wide towards the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths, angled six wide for home and passed tired rivals. SOUND OF DRUMS two to three wide in mid pack, got ridden along from three furlongs out, offered no response. SACRED GROUND leap at the start conceding two to three lengths to the front, settled two to three wide at the rear, came under urging midway on the far turn, angled three to four wide into upper stretch and made no impact. WARRIOR UP three to four wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under urging midway on the far turn, angled four to five wide for home and tired.
