### Footnotes

JOE MOOCH sat reserved two wide, swung three wide into the stretch under some encouragement, tipped a bit wider shortly afterwards, hooked up in a duel with the runner up in the late stages, took over for good with about seventy yards to go and edged away. ESCAPE TO THE MOON broke sharply and was guided over to the rail, showed the way with the rider holding something back, got pounced upon by FREDDIE G., shook free after an extended fight, got re-engaged in combat, this time by the eventual winner, offered resistance before yielding with a few strides left. SEA TO SKY raced three wide to the five-sixteenths pole, picked up interest coming to that station and after clearing FUSAICHI'S SONG was placed closer to the inside to initiate a pace fight with the second place finisher, continued along on that pursuit to midlane before weakening. ROCKET HERO swung four wide into the stretch, lacked a solid response. JESSES GIANT DUNK saved ground to the quarter pole and made no impact. PRIVATE IRVING A disputed the pace from the two path for six furlongs and gave way. CAT MAN FU three wide on the first turn, tired. SUNNYINSEABROOK along the inside early, was never in contention. ONECATS CHANCE urged three wide into the lane, had little left and tired. TEN ED was no factor.
