GREAT INTENTIONS flashed good speed along the inside, contested the pace, drew clear when roused and was kept to a drive to the wire. STORM MINSTREL showed good speed from the outside while in hand, rallied inside turning for home and finished gamely on the rail. BANK AUDIT raced close up along the inside early, came wide for the drive and finished well outside. TRACI GIRL broke awkwardly, was outrun early, raced inside and finished well on the rail. COMACINA raced wide and had no rally. PRETTY IMPOSING contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. SCHEMER raced between rivals and tired.
