### Footnotes

GET ER UP contently rode the rail, staying within striking distance throughout the opening half, was let out a notch prior to vacating the inside in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came into the stretch and took off in earnest after the leader, closed the gap slightly during the run through the furlong grounds, had more success afterwards, went on to collar LAST MINUTE ROSE and kicked away, kept busy to the end. LAST MINUTE ROSE went head to head with STAY COMPOSED for a few strides early down the backstretch, shook off that opponent, using her own power to do to, cut the pace, well rated along the inside until the quarter pole, got let out as the pressure intensified, maintained a clear advantage during the next furlong, got overhauled by the winner in due time but continued onward willingly to secure second. NINA'S PRIDE bobbed at the start, left the three-eighths pole from the three path, proved no match for the top twosome. TESSA B was taken hold of, pulled off STAY COMPOSED at the start, settled in the rear of the pack, got taken hold of again when another rival tucked into the two path just before reaching the end of the backstretch, stayed within range from the outside on the turn, paused when taken hold of a third time, as the eventual winner was angling off the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, ducked over to the inside for the stretch run, weakened leaving the eighth pole. STAY COMPOSED sparred briefly with the runner up soon after the start, continued the chase from the outside for a half and gave way.
