TIGHTEND TOUCHDOWN set the pace inside under some pressure from MISSILEWHILEUWORK early on, continued to save ground in the turn, got displaced by LITTLE DALE near the five-sixteenths when that rival made a brief bid for command, came under a drive at the quarter pole and reestablished the front, edged clear by the eighth pole, saw that lead cut into in the final furlong when drifting in and out in response to the whip, held well to the finish to prevail in an all out drive. FRISKY WARRIOR reserved in midpack while in the two path, came under urging near the five-sixteenths, angled to the rail opened by a tiring rival at the eighth pole, finished with good energy along the rail through the final furlong and just missed the front while just procuring the place. MONEY IN MOTION raced three wide throughout, came under a spirited ride just past the three-eighths, steadily advanced on the front, angled in one path when appearing to refuse to move outside a rival coming to the eighth pole forcing MISSILEWHILEUWORK to steady briefly at that station, continued on with a good finish to be safely along for show while just missing place honors. LITTLE DALE broke well to the front, was settled in behind the pace while three wide, made a middle move for the lead approaching the five-sixteenths and seized command, held the front until the three-sixteenths when displaced at that station, weakened through the final furlong while clear for the last major share. COROFIN saved ground throughout while allowed to settle early, came under rousing at the head of the lane and offered no response. BRASS NOTE hustled early when outrun, chased the pace from the inside and was never a factor. MISSILEWHILEUWORK reluctant to approach the gate prior to loading, lost his footing at the start and recovered to prompt the pace from the two path, came under a drive at the head of the lane, was in the process of being out kicked and showing signs of weakening when forced to steady at the eighth pole by MONEY IN MOTION, lost what momentum he had left at that juncture and tired. COPPER TIGER settled at the rear, took the overland route in the turn and offered little.
