Footnotes

IRISH EDDIE took control right from the get-go, set the splits from the inside, with none of the competition able to keep pace, drew out to a commanding lead from upper to midstretch, remained well clear at the end, winning handily. HEIDEN coaxed along tracking the loose leader from the inside, proved no match. EL CORRIENTE weakly chased the winner from between rivals for a good portion of the way around the turn, got outkicked. TRINITY WARRIOR brushed with CALL THE GENERAL a few strides after the break, was guided over to the rail at the half mile pole, was never involved. CALICO MOUNTAIN away a bit awkwardly, underwent a three wide pursuit, folded. TINTO three wide departing the backstretch, was asked for run by the five-sixteenths pole, tired. CALL THE GENERAL was taken hold after the start after some light contact with TRINITY WARRIOR, raced sluggishly in the early going, took the inside route on the turn and was always outrun.
