REGAL STRIKE three wide in pursuit, came under urging at the three-eighths, advanced on the front into striking distance swinging three wide in upper stretch, took command at the three-sixteenths, inched away, got confronted by PLEASANT PRINCE and headed a sixteenth out, fought head to head jostling with that foe to the wire coming again gamely to win the bob on the wire. PLEASANT PRINCE three wide towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs out, angled four wide in upper stretch, rallied with good energy to confront the aforementioned rival inside the final eighth, took command at the sixteenth marker narrowly, jostled head to head to the wire in game fashion and just lost the bob on the line. EQUIVOCATION attended the pace from just off the inside, came under a ride nearing the quarter pole, took command and led briefly until displaced at the three-sixteenths, offered up a mild kick before weakening in the late stages while safe for the show honors. BELLAMY on the pace inside accompanied from the two path, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch narrowly displaced on the front, kept on mildly to the eighth pole before weakening in the final furlong. FLATOUT ROYAL outrun in the early going, became detached half way from the main body of the field, saved ground through to the top of the stretch, passed tired rivals in the lane while making no impact. FREE BRAVE four wide in mid pack, came under urging at the three-eighths while taking the overland route through the turn offering little, swung five wide for home and tired. QUIET POWER tracked inside just off the pace ridden along from the three-eighths pole, faded in the latter portion of the turn and tired.
