Footnotes

TIZAROCKET hooked up in duel with the runner up shortly after the start, raced heads apart with that foe to the quarter pole, appeared to have been shaken off by the end of the run through the furlong grounds, altered course sharply to the outside as soon as the second place finisher had herself settled along the inside route, this occurring in midstretch, latched on that rival by the sixteenth pole, then outfinished her the rest of the way home to prove best. D' KENNESAW CAT in the two path, sparred on nearly even terms with the winner to the top of the lane, responded positively when given her cue, gained the necessary clearance and tucked along the rail in the vicinity of the furlong marker, left that station holding on to her biggest advantage, had the top one draw alongside once more to do battle a sixteenth down the road, got outkicked and had to settle for the place. NIGHT TIME SLIPPER sneaked into the pocket at the top of the turn, vacated the premises turning for home, proved no match. ANGEL CHOIR chased from the two path and tired. ALICE AND TRIXIE rode the rail, steadied when in a bit tight prior to cutting the corner into the lane, came up empty. HIDDENITE chased the ongoing duel from the two path and gave way.
