RUN A DUBB DUBB came away without apparent mishap, took up the role of primary pursuer, crept up steadily after being let out a notch at the seven-sixteenths marker, was on nearly even terms with the leader a furlong later, worked her way to the front against a much more actively-handled opponent to lead the field into the stretch, albeit by a slim advantage, responded willingly when given her cue and scampered away to begin the final furlong leading by a comfortable advantage, more than doubled it the rest of the way home, doing so primarily under a strong hand ride. WHITE CRANE gave chase from the two path on the bend, got roused near the five-sixteenths marker, swung three wide into the stretch, failed to keep pace with the top one but held on well enough to secure second. LITTLE MISS LUPE argued for command while saving ground, got displaced by the winner while being hand urged, tired steadily after completing the half. IMAGINE TOMORROW saved ground for almost a half, angled four wide into upper stretch, made no headway. JULESCO tracked the front runners pocketed until past the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty. AGILION three wide and lightly bumped near the five-sixteenths pole, fanned a couple of paths wider racing through the furlong grounds, made no impact. BEBES PASSION raced along the outside and was outrun. SPRITELY MAMBO between rivals on the turn, made light contact with AGILION leaving the three-eighths pole, tired.
