STAR HALO raced close up early while in hand, split rivals in the stretch and drew clear under a drive. CONRAD CROSSING was outrun early, rallied three wide on the turn and finished well outside. SAY I DO contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. FEELIN' THE BLUES was steadied on the backstretch, raced in traffic in the stretch and finished well once clear. SHORT WAVE chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. SUCCESSFUL SECRETS contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. BALLSTON had no rally. JUDGE JOHN B. raced three wide and tired. KARAKORUM CHANCE tired after showing brief speed. TAKE A SINGER tired badly and was eased in the stretch.
