Footnotes

CORYBANT put to some hand urging after the start, rushed up outside the front runners at that time to grab the advantage, kicked clear of them and was guided over to the rail, cut the pace on an open lead, was roused past the five-sixteenths pole, emerged from the furlong grounds in possession of his biggest advantage and maintained almost all of it, kept busy to the end. KEYALY was lightly bumped by an errant WINNING GOLD early down the backstretch, was sent over to the rail in short order, left the half mile pole already having been put to solid hand encouragement, rode the rail for an additional furlong before getting taken outward, rallied well belatedly to procure the place. DOWN BROADWAY out broke the field, was placed along the three path midway down the backstretch, stayed as wide making his way around the turn, failed to apply serious pressure on the winner in the role of primary pursuer for most of the initial half, entered the stretch and got outfinished for second. EPIC LEGEND was through after going a half. ECONOMY OF WORDS swung six wide into the stretch, the widest of all, and went on to improve position past a pair of weak and tired foes. WINNING GOLD was put to vigorous cross-reining leaving the starting gate, had the rider lose control temporarily early down the backstretch and came in slightly, but enough to bump lightly with KEYALY, raced along the outside and gave way. DUTCH SMOOTHIE along the inside, was urged on the turn but made no headway on the front runners.
