DANCETERIA came out of the gate alertly and grabbed the early advantage, was sent over to the inside, making it down along the rail well before reaching the end of the backstretch, entered the turn with another pair in hot pursuit, parked out in paths two and three respectively, resumed the battle a furlong down the road but with only the outer of the two previously mentioned opponents, got set down in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, turned for home leading by only a slim advantage, drew off to his largest advantage from upper to midstretch, had it chopped down sizeable piece by sizeable piece by the runner up during the last eighth, but reached the wire in the nick of time to prevail. GREELEY PACK raced three wide, got put to a prolonged drive, found his best stride by the end of the furlong grounds, closed in readily, but fell one jump short of nailing the winner. STREET SWAGG pressed the issue from between rivals from the half mile pole until midway on the turn, fell back steadily when unable to keep pace, then staged the mildest of comebacks to take the show. SUNRISE LOVER four wide departing the backstretch, was no menace. CUVEE CITY ducked outward after stumbling badly at the start, was grabbed hold and put back on a truer course, rushed up under hand urging into a forward position, vied as the widest of three for a furlong starting from the half mile pole, then went at it one on one with the winner the rest of the way around the turn, had little left after entering the stretch and gave way. G W'S HAMMER placed four wide at the head of the stretch, had no serious offerings to give. BUBBA'S CHOICE saved ground, was under a drive by the three-eighths pole, faltered. SELJUK was no factor.
