BLUE CREEK unhurried from off the inside, picked up the pace late on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch, was a couple of jumps into the stretch drive then got tipped one lane further outward, made contact with MINESCAPE near the hind quarters, getting knocked sideways in the direction of the infield as a result, recovered his proper stride in short order, charged towards the front runners leaving the eighth pole, loomed boldly full of run with seventy yards to go, found a resolute foe in the runner up the rest of the way home, but won the bob. STRAIGHT FAX chased the pacesetter from the outside, taking up the task from between rivals for a good portion of the initial half, got set down prior to reaching the quarter pole, forged on ahead to reach the furlong marker in a practical dead heat with CHRISTOPHER'S JOY, grabbed the lead and inched away from that one as well as a couple of other hot pursuers, raced head to head with the winner for the last seventy yards, dug in stubbornly but lost the bob. ANCIENT ROME broke open the gate prior to start, proceeded to come away with no apparent mishap, assumed a forward position, departed the backstretch from the three path and pressed the issue as the widest of a threesome all the way around the turn, lost some ground commencing the start of the stretch run four wide, finished willingly en route for the show. CHASING MOONLIGHT under a firm hold until the five-sixteenths pole, eased out of the pocket entering the stretch, gained ground until mid lane then flattened out. CHRISTOPHER'S JOY argued for command with at least two other rivals before weakening in the final sixteenth. MINESCAPE three wide entering the turn, was five exiting it, got bumped by the winner losing position in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, had no rally.
