TALENT N PASSION cut the pace inside through solid fractions, got set down at the head of the lane, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in leg weary under threat from a trio inside the final seventy yards, drifted out despite off sided stick work a path or two and held on to prevail. E Z PASSER forwardly placed just off the inside in pursuit, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, gained belatedly on the weakening front outside a pair late and missed. STARSHIP ELUSIVE saved ground towards the rear early on, advanced inside through the turn coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch, angled out a path a sixteenth from home gaining ground late more the product of the leg weary leader, had that foe drift in front near the finish while securing the show. PERSNICKITY two to three wide in pursuit, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home, steadily gained between foes through the final sixteenth and was in a tad tight nearing the wire while being outfinished by the top trio. GUYANA STAR just off the inside at the rear, got ridden along from the five-sixteenths, offered little. TIDAL SLAM broke out at the start and was corrected, chased the pace three wide from mid pack under urging from three furlongs out, spun five wide into upper stretch and tired.
