Footnotes

GET GORGEOUS settled into midpack after the start, contently rode the rail, picked up interest when asked to departing the backstretch and cut readily into the pacesetter's advantage, was forced to have the pilot take hold when stuck in traffic, starting from a few strides prior to the quarter pole, remained on hold lacking clear sailing for the next sixteenth, altered course towards the middle of the strip, ended the maneuver in the fifth path before getting usable racing room, got set down, closed in on the front runners, collared the runner up in the final stages to prevail. NEWYORK CONSPIRACY kept watch on the leader while taking the inside route, arrived at the quarter pole lacking clear sailing, entered the lane, went onward for a few strides then began to get taken outward, got carried out slightly by a now drifting FINDERS KEY, fought for the lead from between rivals, not wedged in however, forged his way to the front, leading by as much a half length, got nipped by the top one near the wire. MAXANA unhurried, raced towards the two path, fanned outward until six wide while racing through the furlong grounds, came home with good energy down the center of the strip to grab the show. HOUSE ON TOILSOME sat reserved within range from off the inside, tipped outward and proceeded to get angled out from the five-sixteenths pole, was five wide a furlong later, flattened out. WILDICHI saved ground early and mustered up a mild response. FINDERS KEY broke sharply, was put to some brisk hand urging, cleared the field enough to get guided over towards the inside and was put to a more relaxed hold, rated kindly on an open lead, kept at a slight distance from off the rail, came

under pressure during the late stages of the run around the far turn, got asked for run, began to drift out while under siege in upper stretch, relinquished past the eighth pole and steadily backed away. MLE MARGAUX was placed along the rail well before reaching the end of the homestretch, stayed put for nearly three-quarters, swung outward until seven wide midway through the furlong grounds, came up empty. MIDNIGHTINPOSITANO forwardly placed while two to three wide on each bend, gave way. MRS. CALABASH three wide on both turns, tired.
