SWEET BAMA BREEZE pressed the early pace from outside, took the lead nearing the quarter pole end edged away under good handling. TIS CACTUS NELLIE hit the side of the gate at the start, was in hand along the backstretch, angled in on the far turn, awaited room on the turn, angled out entering the stretch and closed late to gain the place. DONNA'S SANDEE was taken in hand while dropping back early, swung four wide entering the stretch and rallied belatedly. EIGHTYFIVE S raced in midpack between horses for a half and lacked a late response. SHIMMERING PAL chased three wide along the backstretch, lodged a brief outside move nearing the quarter pole and flattened out. CHAUETTE rushed up after breaking slowly, steadied along the inside on the far turn, gained slightly on the turn and tired thereafter. ED'S PRINCESS raced wide throughout while being outrun. MRS. HOLDEN showed speed on the rail for a half and gave way.
