Footnotes

JAX MAXX swung off the rail after taking the inside route around the opening bend, was patiently handled for the initial six furlongs, began to pick up the pace leaving the five-sixteenths pole, was set down to urging and spun into the six path at the head of the stretch, the widest of all, got straightened away and commenced to rally in earnest, easily overhauled the runner up in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and drew well clear under good handling. CINDER CONE contested the pace from between rivals in the early stages, shook free midway down the backstretch and was guided over to the rail in time for the run around the second bend, came under pressure from a pair of opponents leaving the three-eighths pole, staved off the challenge and edged away again, had no answer when the winner arrived on the scene a sixteenth beyond the eighth pole, was kept going well enough to take the place. JITALIAN raced three wide around both turns, advanced to issue a challenge for command at the five-sixteenths pole, wasn't up to the task and backed away. FRENCH TRANSITION saved ground until nearing the end of the backstretch, was angled outward for the stretch run, eventually entering the lane from the four path, had a mild stretch response. LOYAL LEADER off the inside, was placed five wide for the stretch drive, had no rally. BUTLER CABIN strung out three wide on the first turn, disputed the pace as the widest of a threesome for a good portion of the first half, kept up the pursuit even after the second place finisher edged away, took another shot at that opponent late on the far turn, from between rivals this time, had little left left after turning for home and tired. AFLEET PEGASUS had a three wide trip, failed to reach contention then was vanned off after the finish. LIBERTY ST. OUTLAW gunned from the starting gate, failed to clear the field, argued for control as the innermost member of a trio for just under a half and faltered.
