BRUSHED ON, unhurried along the inside early on, picked it up when asked approaching the stretch, came through an available opening along the rail inside the eighth pole and was not fully extended under the wire. AMERICAN CHAMP was hustled out to a clear lead, set the pace while removed from the inner railing, settled into the stretch with a clear lead and was outfinished. KING ROLLER raced wide and finished well from the outside. JOHNNY LEGIT had no response when roused. ABLE RED chased outside and tired.
