APPEALING DANGER stumbled after the start, raced close up while three wide, lugged in in midstretch and continued on gamely to the wire. MANOR PROSPECT outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. DONALD'S TOMORROW raced three wide and lacked a solid closing kick. GANGSTA RAP chased the pace along the inside and lacked a finishing kick. LORD OF TIME was hustled from the start but had no response. FIRST SHOT contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
