MRS. DOYLE raced in hand early, advanced while between rivals on the second turn, rallied wide, earned a short lead in upper stretch, dug in when headed inside the eighth pole and came again to get the job done. TAX THE QUEEN was rated along early, rallied three wide into the stretch, angled in for the drive and finished gamely inside. MISS DISCOVER pressed the pace from the outside and weakened in the final furlong. BOUND ON BI was outrun early, raced inside, was caught in traffic in upper stretch, altered course to the outside and finished well. SOUTH WING raced close up along the inside and had no response when roused. SENSITIVE PENGUIN set the pace along the inside and tired after three quarters. PENNY DREAM raced three wide and tired.
