REGAL ENGAGEMENT was rated along outside, advanced outside on the second turn, lugged inward in upper stretch, rallied on the rail, angled out in deep stretch and got up in the final strides. TRENDY LADY was bumped after the start, quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, drew clear when roused and dug in gamely on the rail. DAYTIME PROMISE was outrun early, advanced inside on the second turn, was steadied behind the winner in upper stretch, altered course to the outside and finished gamely. LAST ROMANCE raced close up along the inside, moved up inside nearing the stretch, came wide for the drive and stayed on well to the finish. LADY RAJ was outrun early, raced wide on the second turn and had no rally. NO REASON was bumped after the start, pressed the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. GORGEOUS MISTRESS was bumped after the start, chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. A claim of foul against the winner by the rider of the third place finisher, alleging interference at the quarter pole, was not allowed.
