PARKINSON FIELD sat within striking distance throughout the opening three-quarters, was lightly urged to maintain position, turning for home, placed directly behind a wall of rivals spread three deep across the track, steadily advanced as that previously mentioned barrier dissipated, altered course to the middle of the strip for optimal racing clearance, kicked in as soon as the maneuver was completed, gained readily on ADIRONDACK WARRIOR, collaring that opponent in the final seventy yards to prove best. ADIRONDACK WARRIOR dove to the rail soon after departing the gate, lagged behind, devoid of early speed, was moved into the two path just prior to reaching the half mile pole, advanced forward during the run around the second bend, turned for home four wide losing no momentum, rallied with good energy to emerge from the furlong grounds the clear cut leader, dug in determinedly as the top one narrowed in, relinquished the lead with about seventy yards remaining, but continued on with fortitude to garner the place honors. NOBODY LIKE MIKE forwardly placed under a firm hold, issued a three wide bid for command upon entering the second turn, with the rider still attempting to keep something in reserve, was released from the grip approaching the three-sixteenths pole, was taken in hand after coming out a couple of paths, in response to strong left handed pressure at the furlong marker and steadily weakened thereafter. MERLIN BAY placed five wide at the head of the lane for the stretch drive, finished willingly to secure the final major slice of the pot. PEGASUS ENA underwent a three to four wide journey, was asked for a response at the five-sixteenths

pole but failed to fire appreciably. GIMMEANOTHERWINK three wide around the opening turn, was no factor. NEXT DAY raced three wide around the first turn, continued off the inside thereafter and failed to menace. BAI BAI DUBAI patiently stalked the early pacesetter, bid successfully for the front leaving midpoint on the far turn, relinquished it soon afterwards and backed away. THE PLOT THICKENS broke running, set the pace from the inside, gave way readily to pressure late on the far turn and wilted.
