QUE POSSE chased the pacesetter while racing along the outside, lost contact with that opponent, despite being asked for run coming to the five-sixteenths pole, continued onward, cut into the gap steadily during the final furlong, getting the head down in time at the wire to prevail. NOT NOW ASHLEY away well, needed only a few strides to take control, was rated on an open lead, deliberately kept slightly off the inside, spurted away from the closest, still under his own power during the later stages of the run around the bend, still maintained a comfortable advantage midstretch, saw it dwindle down during the ensuing eighth, getting nailed in the final jump. PERCUSSION raced along the outside and proved no match for the top twosome. INSPEIGHTOFMYSELF bumped with VAMEL leaving the gate, was three wide at the half mile pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. VAMEL came out a bit, bumping with the nearest rival to the right, had a ground-saving journey thereafter and failed to be a factor. DOODLEMAN hustled from the gate to assume a forward position, saved ground and tired. WRIGHT RENDEZVOUS steadied at the start, was outrun.
