Footnotes

DIABLO'S FIRE assumed a forward position during the straightaway approach leading up to the opening bend, contently stalked the pacesetter from the outside and under a firm hold for nearly a half, advanced readily when given some rein departing the backstretch, drew alongside and hooked up in a duel with the runner up, raced on even terms with that opponent, with only a head separating the pair, put his in front at the furlong marker, finally shook free a sixteenth down the road, edging away from that point under a drive. SEVENTH STAR (IRE) made the front under the mildest of urging, was rated on the lead along the inside, untested until about midpoint on the far turn, sparred intensely with the top one, fell a bit behind with an eighth remaining, fought bravely to regain command, could no longer keep pace in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, but continued on with good courage to be second best. BOLD VINDICATION unhurried along the outside, was taken to the rail coming to the three-eighths pole, cut the corner into the lane under a full drive and rallied mildly to grab the show. SILVER BIRCH off the inside, was put to a prolonged drive and got out finished. PRESSURE POINT three wide around both turns, was through after completing three-quarters.
