Footnotes

EXCITING MISSILE made steady progress after settling while two to three wide in the turn, came under urging at the midway point, swung three wide at the quarter pole, took command at the three-sixteenths and drew clear being kept busy to the end. EYES ON THE STORM tracked the pace from the two path, initiated pressure on the front coming to the five-sixteenths, poked a head in front turning for home, came under pressure soon after himself, succumbed the lead at the three-sixteenths when drifting in from right handed stick work, continued on well to be clearly second best while no match for the top one. BLAKE STREET BULLY broke sharply and was allowed to settle under patient handling towards the rear, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide turning for home, kicked on belatedly with good energy to secure the show safely while never a threat to the top two. BACKDRAFTER broke well, set the pace inside while under a hold, came under intensified pressure coming to the five-sixteenths, was encouraged to go on at that juncture, got displaced at the quarter pole, remained prominent until the final furlong and weakened in the latter portion of the stretch drive. NORTHERN RUSH was prominent being coaxed along while three wide until the eighth pole, steadily faded thereafter. SUAVE SAILOR tracked the pace in midpack inside throughout, came under urging at the five-sixteenths and offered no response. OFFSHORE SCORE hustled from the gate, chased the pace from the rail, steadied briefly at the nine-sixteenths and again just past the five-sixteenths, continued under a drive and tired. ONE GOLDEN CAT outrun in the early stages, was never a threat.
