DEALING LUCKY sat reserved off the rail during the early going, picked up interest and speed after being asked for a response departing the five-sixteenths pole, split rivals swinging four wide into the stretch and under a full drive by now, was quickly straightened away, having lost little if any momentum, rapidly cut into the front runner's advantage with every stride, collaring the leader in the final seventy yards to prove best. LOOKIN AT HER patiently stalked the leader from the outside under a firm hold for nearly a half, moved up to challenge that opponent in earnest entering the stretch, fought his way to a slim lead a furlong down the road, dug in stubbornly to preserve it, but couldn't match the top one's kick, finally yielding a short distance prior to the finish. LEAP DAY put almost to a drive from the start, grabbed the lead midway down the backstretch, was placed under a good hold and rated along the rail while setting the opening splits, was put to a hard drive once again, this time from the quarter pole, reluctantly surrendered the front to the runner up nearing the eighth pole, battled hard to come back but had to settle for the show. CALLMETONY gave chase from the outside, beat KARAKORUM ON BLACK in a race to the three path coming to the five-sixteenths pole, spun from there into the stretch, was set down but failed to muster up the needed response. KILN CREEK devoid of early foot, slowly worked his way forward to rejoin the pack during the run around the bend, angled off the inside in upper stretch and rallied with good energy, belatedly. HALF A NOTE saved ground and tired after going a half. KARAKORUM ON BLACK underwent a three to four wide journey and folded.
