FEROCIOUS WON chased the runaway leader from afar while positioned off the inside, turned for home three wide, closed in readily after being set down in upper stretch, forged on ahead, despite being carried out badly by an errant BANKING HOLIDAY, exchanged bumps with ZOSOGOOD, the middle member of the trio slugging it out down the stretch, then managed to get the head down in time to nicely complete a troubled journey. ZOSOGOOD off alertly, chose a change of tactics after the runaway leader was sent off and running to establish a loose lead, bided time stalking that opponent while travelling off the inside, closed the gap somewhat during the run around the far turn, came inward from right handed stick work nearing the three-sixteenths pole, bumping soundly with BANKING HOLIDAY, proceeded a short distance onward, got carried outward by the aforementioned rival as that foe drifted badly from heavy left handed pressure, forged on, wedged between foes as the eventual first three finishers moved past the staggering early pacesetter, traded bumps with both FEROCIOUS WON and BANKING HOLIDAY as they trudged towards the wire, and came up short at the end. BANKING HOLIDAY rode the rail, was bumped by the runner up approaching the three-sixteenths pole, appeared to bull his way off the inside to escape a fast-fading rival lying just up ahead, leaving that station, drifted out badly in response to strong left handed pressure, herding out both top two finishers as a result, continued to drift and herd out that pair bumping with the runner up along the way during the final sixteenth, while settling for show honors at the end. COLIE Z a bit unsettled split seconds before the gate was sprung open, steadied at the start, recovered and was rushed up to take charge, sped off to a lengthy advantage, took the field as far as he could, was coming to a halt nearing the eighth pole, and tired steadily thereafter. CHARING CROSS saved ground to no avail. LOHAD was outrun. ECRU EGRET trailed.
