ISN'T SHE GRAND disputed the pace from the three path, with the rider applying a firm hold all the while, moved past BERNADETTE'S SONG to take over in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, still unasked for any serious run, responded positively when let out approaching the three-sixteenths pole, drew out to a commanding advantage and had enough of a head start on the runner up leaving the eighth pole to safely fend off that rival. KISSA MELISSA devoid of early foot down the backstretch, picked up the pace after reaching the turn, swung gradually wide for the stretch drive, had to settle for being widest of all, placed in the six path at the head of the lane, then charged down the center of the track with good energy to be clearly second best. BERNADETTE'S SONG vied for the lead while travelling in the two path, was displaced on the front leaving the three-eighths pole, held reasonably well to the finish line to salvage show honors. PUT ME FIRST raced along the outside and lacked the necessary stretch response. STORM GAL three wide at the three-eighths pole, failed to reach a contending position. SISTER'S SPEED rode the rail, showed a burst of speed from the five-sixteenths to the quarter pole accelerating into contention, cut the corner into the lane but soon flattened out. IBERIAN GATE broke slowly, after tossing her head to and fro, split seconds before the field was sent off and running, quickly settled into stride, readily worked her way into a forward position, under her own power, down the backstretch, underwent a four wide pursuit for most of the way around the bend but was spent after completing the opening half.
